RULES

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA. The general playing rules and tournament rules of the BTBA along with the following special rules will govern this event. This is a closed tournament. Only current members of the Lancashire BTBA who must produce their membership card when registering can enter. No card, no play.
2. The tournament manager will be Edwin Whitehead who reserves the right to rule on any point that arises and which is not covered by the rules, subject to an appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be made in writing to the tournament manager within 30 minutes of the completion of the game in question and prior to the presentation. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute that cannot be resolved at the time. In the event of a tie for any placing position the highest last game will count. All competitors are required to dress in suitable bowling wear. Jeans or denims will not be allowed. Ladies/girls will be permitted to wear skorts.
3. The event shall be handicapped for singles, doubles and team with a scratch masters junior and adult sections. Bowlers may enter any combination of the events. The top 8 scratch bowlers from the all events in both junior and adult sections will be bowl three further scratch games (previous scores not carried forward). If a junior qualifies for the adult master section then they can choose which tournament they enter. The top 4 bowlers will then play a one game stepladder final in each age group. (4th v 3rd , winner plays 2nd, winner plays 1st)
4. Bowlers must declare their highest current league or tournaments average over 21 games, which should be ratified by their league secretary. The tournament manager reserves the right to reject or re rate or reclassify any bowlers average. Handicaps shall be based on 80% of the difference between the entering average and 200 with a maximum of 65 pins per game.
5. The entry fee for Adults is £11 per person per event (£33 for all 3 events) which includes £3.50 prizefund (returned 100%) and £0.20 Team England contribution. The entry fee for Juniors is £10 per person per event (£30 for all 3 events) which includes £3.50 prizefund (returned 100%) and £0.50 Junior Team England contribution.
6. Entries should be in by midnight on Sunday 6th May 2007.
